

ITEM **Ethernet CO Connecting Link**
610.29**1. Service Description**

SaskTel will provide to registered Canadian Carriers and Digital Subscriber Line Service Providers (DSLSPs) Ethernet Central Office Connecting Link arrangements with transmission paths from the Interconnecting Carrier's, or DSLSP's, co-located central office building space to the transport cross-connect panel within the central office for the purpose of transmitting at a speed of 10 Base-T, 100 Base-T or 1000 Base-SX.

2. Definitions

For the purposes of this Tariff Item:

“Ethernet CO Connecting Link” is a transmission path which connects a SaskTel provided Ethernet Access, an Ethernet Transport Interface (ETI), or an Aggregated High Speed Service Provider Interface (AHSSPI) located within a SaskTel Central Office (CO) building to a co-locator's transmission equipment located within the SaskTel CO building.

“10 Base-T Ethernet CO Link” is a connecting link that joins a SaskTel provided network component to a co-locator's transmission equipment located within the SaskTel CO. A 10Base-T Connecting Link terminates at a transmission rate of up to 10 Mbps.

“100 Base-T Ethernet CO Link” is a connecting link that joins a SaskTel provided network component to a co-locator's transmission equipment located within the SaskTel CO. A 100 Base-T Connecting Link terminates at a transmission rate of up to 100 Mbps.

“1000 Base-SX Ethernet CO Link” is a connecting link that joins a SaskTel provided network component to a co-locator's transmission equipment located within the SaskTel CO. A 1000 Base-SX (Gigabit) Connecting Link terminates at a transmission rate of up to 1000 Mbps.

3. Conditions of Service

1. Ethernet CO Connecting Links are used in conjunction with Ethernet Access Service, an ETI, a component of Ethernet Transport Service or an AHSSPI, a component of Aggregated Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL) Service, which the customer subscribes to from SaskTel. C

2. SaskTel does not make any representation that these arrangements shall at all times be available in the quantities requested and at the locations specified by the registered Canadian Carrier or DSLSP co-locating in SaskTel's Central Office(s). SaskTel shall, however, make every effort to make such arrangements available on request.
3. Under this Tariff Item DSLSP's that are not Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (CLECs) may not use CO Connecting Link arrangements to provide switched local voice services.
4. 10 Base-T, 100 Base-T and 1000 Base-SX CO Connecting Links are provided in single increments.

4. Rates

The Interconnecting Canadian Carrier or DSLSP shall pay to SaskTel the following rates and charges for Ethernet CO Connecting Link arrangements. Such rates and charges are in addition to any other rates and charges that may be applicable.
